FIRM'S OWNER ELECTED PRESIDENT OF INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION

Midland, TX – May 18, 2006 - WesTex Document Inc. announced today the election, in Phoenix this week, of their company owner and CEO, to the position of President-Elect of the National Association for Information Destruction, Inc. (NAID). They have been a member of the Midland Chamber of Commerce since 1997 and Mr. Miller is a Leadership Midland graduate, Class of 2000.

"When I formed WesTex Document in 1997 in Midland, I never perceived a long-range goal of being a leader of the industry - nonetheless President of a international trade association," said Mr. Miller. "As a business owner, I've always believed that you should be the best at what you do, help others to do the same, and provide the best service possible to your customers and that is what I set out to do in 1997. I credit my experience through the Leadership Midland chamber program with part of my success."

Mr. Miller has served as a business mentor to others entering the secure document destruction business across the country over the years and those efforts were recognized by his election to lead the organization from the only seat on the Board of Directors that has a term of three years.

Mr. Miller is also a member of the Association of Records Managers and Administrators (ARMA International) and belongs to the Midland/Odessa ARMA Chapter, having served on their Chapter Board of Directors at one point. He is also a member of the Professional Records & Information Services Management (PRISM International) and well known in PRISM from his articles that they have published. Both trade associations held a joint annual membership meeting and convention this week in Phoenix at the Arizona Biltmore. PRISM and NAID held joint conferences this year at the Arizona Biltmore in Phoenix.
